Location & Parking	Assembly and car parking at TL833853 on north side of B1107 between Thetford and Brandon. Signed from B1107; competitors travelling from the Thetford direction will continue past the Assembly area before turning right into the access road to the car park. Competitors will be crossing the B1107 on the way to Start and Finish please slow down on approach and obey road and parking marshals' instructions. Parking is along a wide forest ride. <u>No car parking fee</u> . Parking for coaches by arrangement – please contact the Organiser in advance.		
Terrain	Mainly coniferous forest at various stages of maturity with complex pattern of thickets and interesting contour detail providing more climb than is usual in Thetford areas.

Entries	Entry to <b>ALL</b> Competition courses is by pre-entry via Fabian4 ( <a href="http://www.fabian4.co.uk">www.fabian4.co.uk</a> ) strictly by the <u>closing date</u> of 8 <sup>th</sup> February 2012. All competitors are advised to check which course to enter with their Club Captains before entering; and to consult their Club Captains if they have any difficulty in using Fabian4 to enter. Start times will be allocated by the Organiser according to the Rules and in consultation with Club Captains and will take into account as far as possible individual preferences (such as split times for parents).
